Gmail for Students

- Implemented due to aging email system and failing hardware
- Allowed for automatic creation of email for every admitted student
- Currently over 30,000 accounts enabled

Touchnet Payment Processing

- Touchnet is the payment processor for Purdue University
- First implemented at IPFW as a local server install
- Moved to the cloud as a hosted service when Purdue University bought into the contract

Blackboard Learning Management

- Originally installed on series of servers on campus as DotCMS
- DotCMS was purchased by Blackboard and Purdue University purchased license for all sites – IPFW retained individual license
- When Purdue implementation was not up kept IPFW decided to move to a Blackboard hosted implementation

Tegrity Classroom Capture

- Implemented to provide classroom/slide capture for distance/online students
- Local video/audio captured by instructor station, processed and sent to the cloud where it is inserted into the online class
- Tegrity is then linked into the class Blackboard pages

IPFW Media Vault - Kaltura

- IPFW Media Vault stores all current video content that is needed for faculty use.
- Kaltura is the cloud product that is used to provide the storage and playback services of the Media Vault

Office 365

- Provides email, calendaring, IM, and online storage for Faculty and Staff
- Implementation began last spring with final data moves expected by this spring (last user cleanup)
